This 15-question score sheet was used to measure the religiosity of the 27 funder groups.

Inter-organizational Questions

[response options: A lot (1 point), Some (0.5 points), No evidence (0 points)]

- 1. To what extent does the organization actively seek to have participants join its faith tradition?
- 2. To what extent are religious practices incorporated into the organization's programs/activities?
- 3. To what extent are the organization's services distributed primarily to individuals or organizations who share the same faith as the organization?
- 4. How frequently does the organization work with external religious entities (e.g., partner with other religious nonprofits, and churches)?
- 5. How frequently are worship services (on-site or virtual) conducted at the organization?

Intra-organizational Questions

- 6. What proportion of the staff is clergy?
- 7. What proportion of the staff shares the same faith as the organization?
- 8. How often do the staff and volunteers pray or worship together?
